The new internationally focused MBA has been developed with your future employability in mind and is aimed at those graduates who are new to the workplace or who wish to move straight from an undergraduate degree. Graduates with an MBA can expect to earn significantly more per year compared to someone only holding a Bachelor's degree (Sutton Trust, 2013).

The increased focus on an international perspective recognises the changing international business environment and the need for managers of the future to possess the knowledge and skills to cope with this 'new global' market reality. The course is designed for aspiring managers and will allow them to cope effectively within, and lead, the organisations of the future.

This programme combines academic learning with work experience opportunities. You will have the chance to work with companies on specific projects, both in the form of internship placements and as academic projects as part of your studies. For those that opt not to undertake a placement (and subsequent in-company project), you will complete a dissertation or research project, as part of the programme.
